What is Motor Neuron Disease (MND)?

Motor Neurone Disease (MND) is an umbrella term used for a group of diseases that affect the functioning of motor neurones. Symptoms include breathing difficulties, fatigue caused by muscle exhaustion, metabolic changes, weight loss and reduced food intake, decreased lung capacity. Insomnia caused by discomfort, pain from stiff joints and muscles. Mild changes in cognitive skills and processes and/or behavioural change. On average the time of death after diagnosis is 3-5 years.
